HUCBMS TRAVEL FELLOWSHIPS 2016

The Executive Committee of HUCBMS offers two annual Fellowship Travel Awards to encourage collaboration in biomedical sciences teaching and research between UK-based and overseas universities. **One award of £1,000 will be available to applicants from non-EU countries and the other, of £500, to EU-based applicants.** The awards are designed to facilitate the successful Fellows to visit at least three UK HUCBMS member institutions and to develop a plan of collaboration with one or more of these institutions in teaching and learning and/or research in the biomedical sciences. The Fellows, or their UK principal collaborator, will be required to give a presentation at the subsequent HUCBMS Annual Conference. (HUCBMS will not be responsible for the travel costs of Fellows to and from the UK).

Applications should be made electronically using the application form 'HUCBMS Fellowships 2016' and submitted to the Hon Executive Secretary (mckennagerry@yahoo.com) not later than **Friday 19 February 2016**.

Applicants will be informed of the outcome of their applications by mid-March 2016. The successful Fellows will each receive a HUCBMS parchment denoting their award.
